Welcome back from Sweden!

This term, pupils from Year 5 and 6 got to travel to Sweden to visit the swedish pupils and meet pupils from the school in Spain we have been working with over the last few years.

Our trip to Sweden

During the trip the group of children from Parkgate visited lots of places while they were away. They visited the town and the school in Tärnsjö. They stopped off in Stockholm to explore the city. They also went to a farm and went on a long walk of around 10 km. On one afternoon they also had a barbeque and a party.

In Sweden our classmates ate a variety of foods. One evening some of them got to have dinner with families from the local town while others had their dinner at the school. The school and families generously served food including tacos, burgers, pizza, rice, hotdogs and several different types of meat dishes as well as Mcdonalds.

In Sweden they often do something called Fika. Fika is like a break where you eat cakes and dessert things. In Sweden it is regular ritual to take Fika which can't be done at your desk or where you work. Some of the sweet treats they had were coconut brownies, a range of cakes and sometimes hot chocolate. Our classmates got to try what having fika was like. Fika was usually at night after they had dinner.
