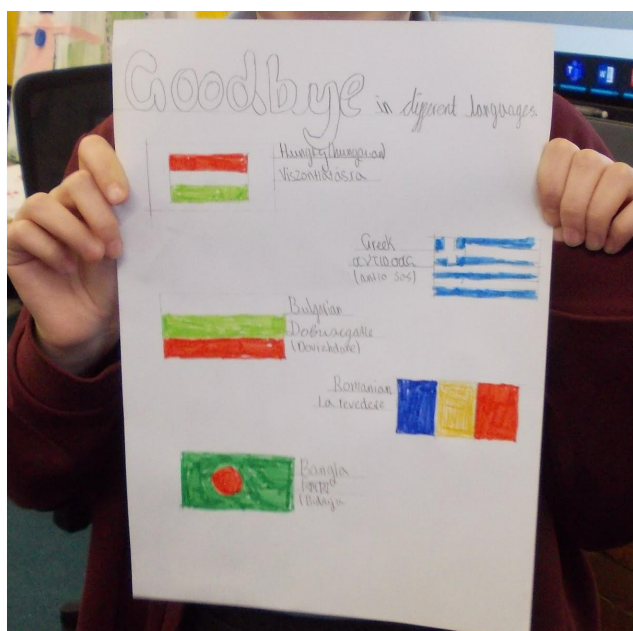

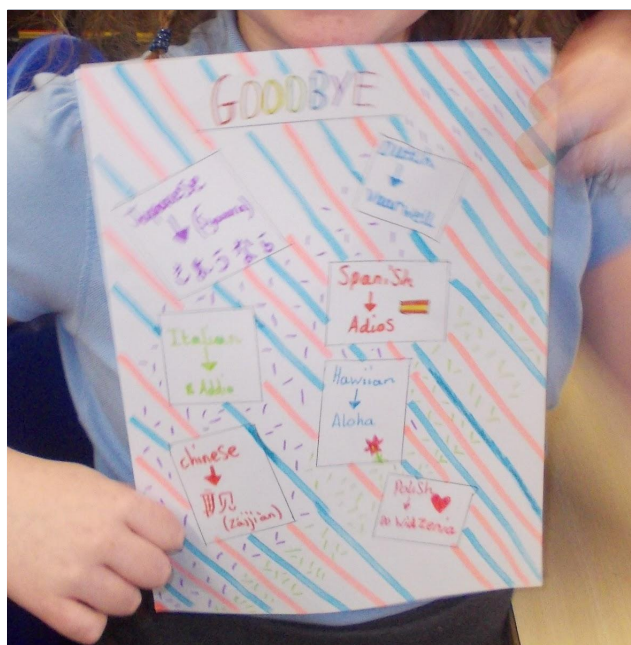


Year 4 - How to say goodbye in other languages

In year 5 they have been learning different languages as well. They completed many mother tongue activities to showcase the many languages they speak too.

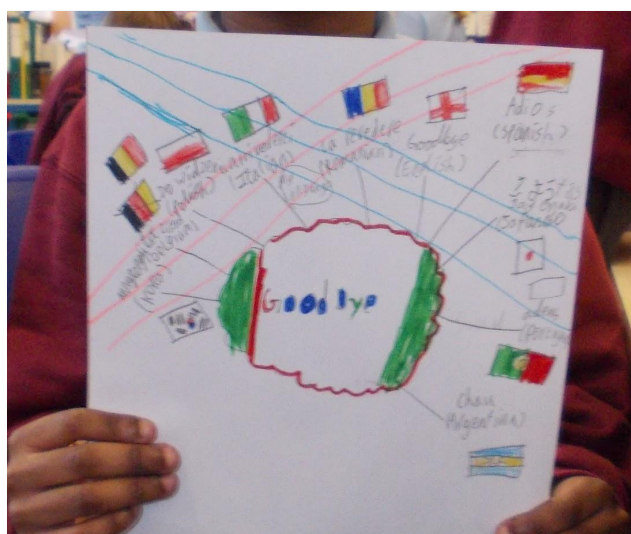
Answers: 1= French, 2= Mandarin, 3= Urdu, 4= Welsh
