Year 4 - What did the Romans ever do for us? In School, we are covering...

Maths

- Help your child to learn to tell the time in a variety of formats: minutes past/to, 12- and 24-hour times, digital/analogue.
- Ask questions about time e.g. How long will it be until dinner, bed...
- In shops ask your child to add up 2-3 items, or calculate the change.
- Learn times tables up to 12x.
- Number bonds to 10/100/1000.
