



Work for Year 6 during the Summer Term 2026

During the summer term the focus in Year 6 is on preparation for moving to Year 7.

Literacy and Maths:

Our focus will be on ensuring children are confident with their key skills and revising content from Key Stage 2. In Maths, this will include fluency, fractions, the four operations and problem solving. In Literacy, we will be developing writing stamina in a range of contexts and improving reading skills such as retrieval and inference.

Science and PSCH/ RSE:

In Science we will be focussing on light and shadows, classification of living things and learning about the human body's development. This will link to our PSCH/RSE which will be looking at the emotional and physical changes that occur as we develop into adulthood.

Topic:

We will complete our study of the Silk Road in History / Geography and start a new unit called Around the World in 80 Days. This will focus on geographical knowledge and skills and comparing different environments. We will be doing project work about different continents using Google Classroom. We will also be holding auditions for our Year 6 play.

Trips/ visits:

PGL and Activity week will take place in the second half of the term.

Transition work:

A vital part of the term's work will be to prepare pupils for the next big step in their education. We will hopefully have in-person visits from all secondary schools as well as working on a variety of tasks and workshops to prepare your children on a practical and emotional level for the changes ahead.

Homework:

We will continue to set weekly homework virtually using Learning by Questions website.
